#### WEEKLY REPORTING REQUIREMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH (DOSHS) ON COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOP) DURING THE PERIOD OF RECOVERY MCO

We refer to MIA Circular to Member Firms on [Daily Reporting Requirement of the Department of Occupational Safety and Health \(DOSHS\) on Compliance with Standard Operating Procedure \(SOP\)](#) dated 22 May 2020.

In the above Circular, the Institute highlighted that DOSHS had announced that daily reporting on compliance with SOP is a requirement for all operating businesses during the period of Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) starting from 20 May 2020.

Kindly take note that during the period of recovery MCO (RMCO), only weekly reporting is required to be submitted through MITI website at <https://notification.miti.gov.my/login>.
