COVID-19 MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER FURTHER EXTENDED TO 28 APRIL 2020.

Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin today announced a further extension of the Movement Control Order (MCO) which was initially scheduled to end on 14 April 2020. The MCO is now extended until 28 April 2020. The Government has also agreed that selected sectors will be opened in stages and will operate following health guidelines and stringent movement control. More information on these sectors will be announced in the coming days.

The Malaysian Institute of Accountants (MIA) will continue to comply with the MCO and all related Government directives, including the closure of all our premises. All events are also postponed until further notice and our staff will continue to work from home during this time.

Despite the challenges arising from the COVID-19 pandemic, MIA is able to communicate and collaborate virtually with our staff, members and diverse stakeholders across a myriad of digital channels to provide remote support. This includes the launch of a dedicated COVID-19 webpage that provides a one-stop access to essential resources, updates and guidance, including relevant information pertinent to our members and stakeholders.
